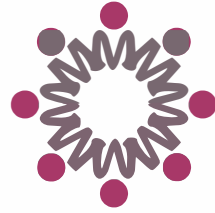
To improve the quality of life for those affected by multiple myeloma.

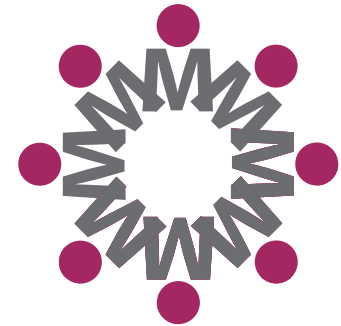
